

**THESIS GRANT
APPLICATION GUIDELINES 2009-2010**

The following guidelines, consisting of regulations and conditions prepared by the RESS Thesis Grants Committee, must be satisfied by the applicant. The committee consists of the President of RESS, Vice President Finance, and the Academic Commissioner.

The objective of the committee is to ensure the proper regulation of the distribution of the Thesis Grants to fourth year engineering students.

1. All applications and subsequent thesis projects should contain a high level of professionalism and should follow the spirit of the Thesis guidelines outline by the PEO.
2. Projects must be an extension of the curriculum of the applicant's department. Of major consideration in the process will be the quality of the final product.
3. The applicant must have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.00
4. The required documentation includes:
 - A copy of Ryerson student transcripts, indicating G.P.A (A ROWS printout is acceptable).
 - A detailed account of expenses incurred during the thesis, including copies of all receipts.
 - A copy of the completed thesis to be evaluated and stored in archive. An electronic copy, such as a CD, is acceptable.

Failure to submit any of the above items will result in the application being refused.

5. Administrative costs such as binding and photocopying will be covered to a maximum of \$50.00 by the thesis grants.
6. Any items, which would be of future personal benefit (i.e. software, calculators, etc.), will **NOT** be covered.
7. The amount of the grant will be decided by the current committee and will be based on the number of applications, the amount of money requested and academic and professional criteria set by the committee.
8. A grant may or may not cover the entire amount requested and will be subject to discretion of the committee.
