1 Important information

1.1 Background Information

Please be sure to read the most recent version of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Ryerson Engineering Student Society prior to proposing a change to the By-Laws. The most recent versions of these documents are available at <http://www.ryeng.ca/>. Please note that according to Article 12 in the Constitution, the Constitution may only be amended during the Annual General Meeting. The purpose of the Semi-Annual General meeting is to amend the By-Laws.

1.2 Clarity

Motions must be thoroughly explained and clear. There is to be no ambiguity in the phrasing of a proposed by-law, nor excessive literalism in the interpretation of current by-laws.

1.3 Stipulations

A By-Law Proposal or Amendment Proposal will be considered only if the following conditions are met:

1. All required information, as outlined by this form, is provided.
2. It is submitted by 11:59 pm on Thursday, October 21, 2010. Submissions may be made either in person to the RESS office (Kerr Hall East 123), or emailed to vpadmin@ress.ca
3. The proposal is signed by no less than fifteen (15) Ryerson Engineering Student Society members. General members and members of the Board of Directors are all eligible for signage.

By submitting this form, you confirm that you have read and understood the content above.

2 Completing the Form

Each type of proposal corresponds to a certain section in this form. You may omit blank sections from your submission. All fields in these sections are mandatory for consideration of your proposed motion.

Section 4 (signature page) must also be completed.

2.1 Proposing a New By-Law

If proposing that a new by-law be added to the RESS By-Laws, complete Section 3 of this form.

2.2 Proposing an Amendment to an Existing By-Law

If proposing an amendment to an existing Article in the RESS By-Laws, complete Section 4 of this form. A motion that would both amend an existing bylaw, and add a new one falls under this section.
